Dear Mesa Vista School District Families,

We are writing to let you know that we have received many new reports this week from staff members and students who are ill, or have tested positive for covid, or who are caring for ill family members.

As such, we are sorry to share that **we are continuing remote learning for the next week. During this period, we will continue with meal service with delivery along the bus routes. Route times will remain the same and drivers will provide a lunch and a breakfast to each student along the route at their regular stop. We will continue with athletics and activities during this time. Coaches and sponsors will be in contact with students to communicate necessary information.**

**At this point, we anticipate being able to bring back all grades on Monday, January 31.** Obviously, this is an evolving situation, so please watch for any further updates.

We are also preparing to host a booster clinic for anyone over the age of 12-18 (Pfizer) and 18 and older (Moderna). We are scheduled to host a clinic on Wednesday January 26<sup>th</sup> at the Mesa Vista School Based Health Clinic.

If you would like to receive the booster please email me [albert.martinez@mesavista.org](mailto:albert.martinez@mesavista.org) by the end of business on Thursday January 20<sup>th</sup>. We need at least 6 kids 12–18-year-olds to participate and at least 28 individuals 18 years or older to participate to host the booster clinic.

\* Individuals having tested positive for COVID in the past 90 days **are** eligible for vaccinations and/or boosters **two weeks after positive test.**

**If you have received monoclonal antibodies, you will need to wait 90 days after treatment to receive a booster shot.**
